I'm excited to have you join us for a hands-on Zoom workshop with beginning audio techniques used by top forensic experts and by Hollywood soundtrack editors to clarify audio files.

To make this work, each of you will need to download trial software to your own computer. This means you will need to attend this workshop in front of a desktop or laptop computer. Prior to the class — preferably two days or at least one day before — follow the below instructions to install iZotope RX 7 Advanced onto your computer.

This workshop will definitely NOT work if you attend from only your phone.

Also, the best way to understand and learn at this particular workshop is to have a good set of headphones attached to your computer or to have speakers attached to your computer — the built in speakers on your computer will not work as well to hear the results of our learning.

Included are two sample audio files we will be clarifying through the use of this software. My plan is to show you how we can remove certain noises and sounds from an audio recording. I am certain that if you prepare the above that the step-by-step workshop will be very interesting and eye opening!

Here are the specifics about downloading 10-day trial version of iZotope RX 7 Advanced:

- 1) Create an account on <https://www.izotope.com/> including giving one's email
- 2) go to <https://www.izotope.com/en/products/rx.html> and press "10-day Free Trial Download" to download the software. (Note the software itself says that the trial lasts for 30 days.)
- 3) After installing the software one has full access to every feature that RX 7 Advanced provides with the exception of being able to save one's work.
